## AUTHOR ECHO FREER TO VISIT 3RD OCTOBER

Echo Freer was born in a small village in Yorkshire and when she was 18 months she moved with her family to Bridlington.

After they moved to York, Echo joined the York City Baths Club and swam competitively. She was the Under 12 Yorkshire breast stroke champion and went on to be the English National Age Group champion at 14 and represented Great Britain in a junior international swimming match.

Echo trained as a PE teacher and then later on became a Special Needs teacher.

She gave up teaching to become a full time writer and has published a number of well reviewed books. We have some of her titles in the Centenary Library.

Echo will be talking to Years 8 and 9 during periods 2-4 on Monday 3rd October. Year 10 are welcome to join us either for the talk or at break time when there will be an opportunity to purchase a signed copy of Echo's books.
