The timetable will be:

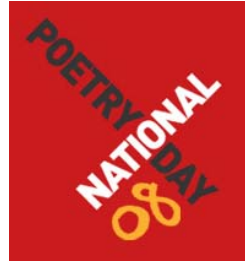
- Monday – Briary**
