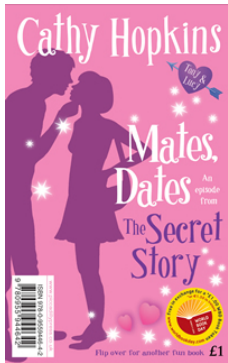

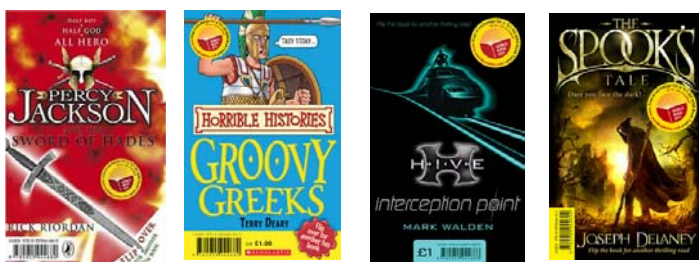


Then, on Wednesday we will see another author when Yvonne Coppard visits us to run writing workshops with girls in Year 7.

As well as Cathy Hopkins’ book, the special £1 books on offer include:



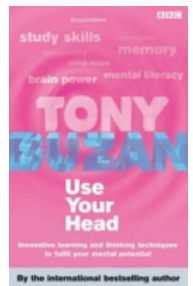
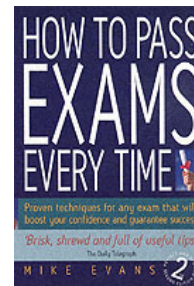
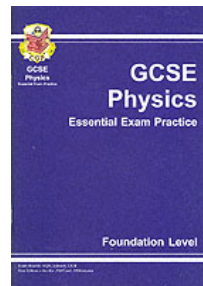
BOOK QUIZ!
