As you are aware Northwood College is committed to recycling and we have recently made arrangements for a company to come and collect our hazardous waste so that it can be disposed of correctly and recycled. This includes florescent light tubes and light bulbs, batteries, computer and printer waste. We have also purchased a bin compactor. This compacts the waste we produce, thereby reducing landfill and freeing up space to have more bins to increase the amount of paper and card waste we recycle. We are also currently in the process of arranging to have our food waste collected to be recycled. The vending cups will shortly be recycled to make crayons and our cooking oil is also being recycled to produce bio fuels. We are continuing to recycle glass and clear plastics too.
